

**VILLAGE BOARD OF GRAFTON**  
**SPECIAL VILLAGE BOARD MEETING MINUTES**

**JUNE 26, 2012**

President Brunnuell called the Village Board meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance followed.

Village Board members present: Jim Grant, Dave Antoine, Richard Rieck, Lisa Harbeck, David Liss, Sue Meinecke, and Jim Brunnuell

Staff / Officials present: Village Administrator Darrell Hofland, Village Attorney Michael Herbrand, Chief of Police Charles Wenten, and Administrative Assistant Deborah A. Brown

**Review and action on issuance of Operators License to Jenny Allen-Sacho**

At this time, Village Attorney Michael Herbrand gave background on this issuance of Operators License to Jenny Allen-Sacho. He further stated that there are pending charges that are recent and have not yet gone to municipal court. It is because of this status that he is recommending at this time that Board approve this issuance of operator's license to Jenny Allen-Sacho with the understanding that Chief Wenten will have discretion on this matter after municipal court findings and can recommend license revocation or other type of action.

President Brunnuell asked when the court date was scheduled.

Ms. Allen-Sacho responded that the first court appearance is scheduled for July 10, 2012 which she will be pleading not guilty and the next date would be shortly after that date.

Attorney Jonathan Woodward stated that the pre-trial would be after that date around July 29, 2012.

Trustee Grant had questioned the charges that were brought against Ms. Allen-Sacho.

Chief Wenten responded by stating that she was charged with lying/obstructing an officer. He further stated that he has concerns regarding the seriousness of these charges.

Attorney Herbrand again stated that the charges are pending and Municipal court will have their due process on this case before a change can be made on this matter by the Village but at this time he is recommending the approval on this operator's license with the understanding that this can be brought back to the Chief for further review in the future.

President Brunnuell then stated that because this case has not gone to court and due process must be done first. It is because of these circumstances that this meeting is being

held and would ask for a motion to approve the operator license at this time to Jenny Allen-Sacho.

Motion by Trustee Harbeck, seconded by Trustee Rieck, to approve the issuance of Operators License to Jenny Allen-Sacho. Approved unanimously.
